
SYMBOLS AND SYNONYMS — CONFUSING FOLLOWERS AND FANBOYS (QD027)

Well damn! I'm sorry, my friend, because I was honestly not aware that all of existence needs to be handled exclusively in terms of your *chosen symbols* and frameworks of reference. What I drop here — does it overlap with the message of your deities, prophets and

so on? Certainly it does. These are universal patterns at the heart of it all. However, it's not exclusive to that particular framing.

But I just really don't feel like playing these games of yours, when you have chosen to comprehend in a tunnel. I'll drop you a reference if it helps you snap out of it — but I'm not playing the epistemic game of only your scripture and the sayings of your gurus are valid information.

So that's all there. If you need to be a follower, adherent, devotee, etc. — well, that's all right. But please try to be a broad-minded, good, respectful

fanboy and fangirl that your teachers, masters and lineage would actually be proud of — instead of being an obnoxious little twat debating on the internet with anyone who is not your guru.
